





Practice!

 - OGetting them up to the board is getting harder.


O Active learning can only go so far.




Content Creation

 (< ~3 minutes)</pre>




oWhat do they have in common?

Streaming

- o A third category: Streaming.
 - OPodcast format is naturally longer.
 - Regular schedule.
 - OWeekday evening.
 - ORecitation from their own room!
 - O Key difference: a Live broadcast!
 - OLimited scripting or prep ahead of time.
 - OAuthenticity in the flaws.
 - oRecord and post replays for asynchronous viewing.



Streaming

- o Benefits:
 - oStudents spend time with you in a context where they are comfortable.
 - Regular intervals to reinforce skills.
 - o Reruns.
- o Costs:
 - OAbout \$200 in equipment.
 - o 30 minutes of prep per week.
 - o Extra hour of "teaching" per week.

- o This has culminated in my podcast, Wabash After Dark.
 - O Wednesday evenings at 8:00 PM for Intermediate Micro on Twitch (When I teach it).
 - ol bring three problems.
 - Open it up to questions afterward.
 - •No homework questions allowed.
 - o50-70% attendance each live session.

- o Extra session before each exam for all courses.
 - One or two evenings before the exam.
 - ol bring nothing.
 - oThey can submit questions in advance and ask during the session.
 - ol reserve the right to veto.
 - o70-90% attendance each live session.
