What is money?





Money—Anything widely accepted in exchange for goods and services.

Fiat money—A substance or device used as money, having no intrinsic value (no value of its own) or representational value (not representing anything of value, such as gold).






The Global Financial Crisis (2007 – 2009) and subsequent recession

The Fed conducted a series of large-scale asset-purchase programs to ease financial conditions and support economic activity.

These purchases boosted reserves in the banking system to over \$2.8 TRILLION.
