
Why Don't Students Attend Office Hours?

Why Stream?

Informality

Can be a place where students feel more comfortable asking questions because it is outside of the classroom

Accessibility

Can take place at the time students are most likely to attend

Interesting Topics

Can be about something you think is cool!

Community

Can be a place where students interact with one another

Contact

Can be a place where students interact with economics outside of the classroom

WHAT IS RSI?

In 2021, the U.S. Department of Education updated its requirements for **Regular & Substantive Interaction (RSI)** in our online classes in order to promote interaction and engagement with online students, and to distinguish distance education from correspondence courses.

RSI emphasizes instructor-initiated interactions that are scheduled, predictable, and focused on substantive course content. Regular and substantive interactions must:

- Be with an instructor as defined by the institution's accreditor.
- Be mostly initiated by the instructor.
- Be scheduled and predictable.
- Be academic in nature and relevant to the course

Substantive interaction involves direct interaction between the learner and the instructor, such as assessing or providing feedback on a student's coursework; providing information or responding to questions about the content of a course; facilitating a group discussion regarding the content of a course or competency, and other similar activities. In addition to substantive interaction, instructors must be responsive to student's requests for support.

Troy University RSI Policy


Regular and substantive interactions must:

- Be with an instructor as defined by the institution's accreditor.
- Be mostly initiated by the instructor.
- Be scheduled and predictable.
- Be academic in nature and relevant to the course

1. My course includes an "Ask the Instructor" discussion board.
2. My weekly announcements relate to course content, not just deadlines.
3. I respond to students within 24-48 hours, and I clearly state my contact info and response time in the syllabus.
4. I grade promptly with substantive feedback, and my syllabus clearly states when students can expect to receive graded work.
5. My syllabus or home page in Canvas clearly specifies my office hours OR provides a scheduling link. I am available either on Microsoft Teams or via phone during those times.




Different sets of




Add Video, Capture, and Audio using “Add Source”


By clicking add source we can add

- Display (Screen)
- Video Capture Device (Webcam)
- Even Text!
- And others!



Adding New Displays with Scenes

- Adding new scenes allows for different displays that one can change between
- I usually keep a few scenes loaded:
 - One of a desktop input with a webcam
 - One of just webcam
 - One of a document camera or secondary webcam


